Old meets new in this program where works by Grisey and Lindberg are framed by more familiar fare by Beethoven and Mozart. The *Leonore Overture No. 3* gets things started. We then hear Canadian soprano Barbara Hannigan as soloist in *Four Songs for Crossing the Threshold* by Gerard Grisey. *Magnus Lindberg's Souvenir (in Memoriam of Gérard Grisey)* follows (a musical homage to his former teacher) and we conclude with one of the last three symphonies by Mozart: No. 40 in G minor. Alan Gilbert conducts and your host is Alec Baldwin.

Alan Gilbert is joined by two former Artists-in-Residence in works by Beethoven, Dvorak, and former Composer-in-Residence Magnus Lindberg. Dvorak's Carnival Overture opens the program and is followed by the Beethoven Violin Concerto with Frank-Peter Zimmermann as soloist. That's followed by Yefim Bronfman's Grammy-nominated performance of the Piano Concerto No. 2 by Magnus Lindberg. We close with Dvorak's Seventh Symphony, notable for its brooding first movement, dance-like scherzo, and triumphant conclusion. Alec Baldwin is your host.
